

JCC of the East Bay is looking for a new site in Oakland

JCC of the East Bay maintains a site in Oakland for two major Youth programs: Olam Yeladim (OY), our afterschool program and Camp Tzofim, our summer day camp. OY provides a welcoming, safe environment where each child can have fun and make friends as they develop a sense of independence and experience community. We offer a wide array of specialty classes, such as music, art, cooking drama and martial arts. We also celebrate Jewish holidays, Shabbat and other cultural events.

Camp Tzofim is the summer day camp which includes opportunities for swimming lessons, day and overnight trips, and the chance to explore concepts and themes in Jewish culture and history, including Shabbat celebrations every Friday.

Given the right space, the JCC will expand programming into the space as available.

Oakland site specifications:

Minimum capacity of children/day: 75

Location: Oakland, Hwy 13 corridor, but willing to look further afield

Minimum indoor size: 3500 sq. feet, ideally including boys/girls bathrooms, a separate adult bathroom, kitchen, office space; but we can build out as needed

Minimum outdoor size: approximately 5625 sq. ft.; can share this space but not at the same time as another program, must be fenced in; can be flexible in exact size

Other Requirements

Handicap accessible (a one story building is ideal)

1-2 classroom spaces are dedicated

Storage space

Parking easily available for parents and staff

Good properties for consideration

Existing Preschool/School/Afterschool

Temple/Church

Community Center

Restaurant or other small commercial or industrial buildings (but must have the required outdoor space)
